3.2 <u>Administrative Fees</u>: Contractor shall pay an administrative fee of .5% of the total gross revenue from the orders made through this Participating Addendum.

3.3 <u>Reports</u>: Contractor must submit quarterly sales reports which coincide with the Contractor fiscal calendar to the Participating State/Entity Primary Contact managing this contract. The Contractor shall provide Participating State/Entity with an electronic usage report in Excel format. Reports are due 15 days after the end of the quarter.

First Quarter: January through March Second Quarter: April through June Third Quarter: July through September Fourth Quarter: October through December

If no volume took place during the quarter the Contractor shall not be required to submit a report.

6. Price Agreement Number:

All purchase orders issued by Purchasing Entities within the jurisdiction of this participating addendum shall include the Participating State contract number: UVA1999326 and the Lead State price agreement number: MNWNC-125.

7. Individual Customer:

Each State agency and political subdivision, as a Participating Entity, that purchases products/services will be treated as if they were Individual Customers. The Contractor will apply the charges to each Participating Entity individually.

This Participating Addendum and the Master Agreement number MNWNC-125 (administered by the State of **Minnesota**) together with its exhibits, set forth the entire agreement between the parties with respect to the subject matter of all previous communications, representations or agreements, whether oral or written, with respect to the subject matter hereof. Terms and conditions inconsistent with, contrary or in addition to the terms and conditions of this Addendum and the Master Agreement, together with its exhibits, shall not be added to or incorporated into this Addendum or the Master Agreement and its exhibits, by any subsequent purchase order or otherwise, and any such attempts to add or incorporate such terms and conditions are hereby rejected. The terms and conditions of this Addendum and the Master Agreement and its exhibits shall prevail and govern in the case of any such inconsistent or additional terms within the Participating State.
